AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPEN BURNING

BE IT ORDAINED by the TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAFONTAINE, INDIANA:

SECTION ONE

- (a) No person shall burn any material, within the corporate limits of the Town of LaFontaine, in an open fire, or allow any material that has been ignited on their property to smolder or smoke from the hours of 7:00 P.M. TO 6:00 A.M. daily.
- (b) If such burning would be deemed a Public Nuisance by Indiana Code 34-1-52-1 it shall be extinguished promptly.

SECTION TWO


This restriction shall not apply to camp fires where such fires are under the control of a person. Provided, further, that a camp fire is to be extinguished immediately upon completion of its use in such a manner as to not smolder and/or smoke.

SECTION THREE

Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" Infraction to which a judgment of up to \$500.00 may be entered for each violation.
